SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Oregon Chapter of APWA and Oregon T2 Center value the ongoing education for public works employees. We are pleased to offer scholarships for the short schools that are held each year in the spring and the fall. If you or someone you know would benefit from attending one of these educational offerings, but your agency cannot afford to send you, please contact us to find out if a scholarship is available and if you qualify.

Street Maintenance and Collection System Short School Scholarship Program:

- Four (4) Scholarships are available from the APWA Oregon Chapter
- Scholarship criteria will be listed at www.oregon.apwa.net, click on Events and then Training, scroll to bottom.
- Recipients will be recognized and announced in T-2/APWA newsletters
- Scholarship is for Tuition and two (2) nights lodging; lodging will be awarded at the discretion of the scholarship committee and is intended for smaller agencies that have budget constraints
 - Tuition includes only the meals that are included with regular registration fees
 - All other meals are the responsibility of the recipient
 - Lodging (unless awarded with scholarship) and travel is the responsibility of the recipient

Street Maintenance and Collection System Short School Scholarship Program criteria:

- Scholarship is intended for Oregon Agencies only
 - Limited to one (1) scholarship per agency, per school, per calendar year maximum
- Scholarship is primarily intended for new employees that need training, and/or agencies that do not have an adequate training budget; all agencies are eligible
- Scholarship is for one (1) person only
 - Agencies may not send multiple persons for one day under a single scholarship
- One scholarship per person, per school, per lifetime maximum
 - Same person cannot receive a scholarship for additional Street Maintenance and Collection Systems Short School's
- Scholarship recipient must attend school, and turn in CEU card to the APWA Registration Desk
 - This is a requirement even if they do not need the CEU's
 - If recipient is a no-show or misses more than 25% of available classes, their agency will be removed from the eligibility list
- Agencies can substitute a person if prior recipient cannot make it for valid reason
- All substitutions are to be approved in advance of the school, through the APWA Registration Staff

Procedure for Scholarship Recipients:

- Visit www.oregon.apwa.net for scholarship criteria and to download the registration form

- You will receive an acknowledgement or denial letter from the APWA Short School Board.
- Send acknowledgement letter to cameopeg@gmail.com to receive a code that can be used for online registration
