Registration as a Professional Civil Engineer or Certification by the American Institute of Certified Planners is a plus; and experience in local government, economic development, and working with an airport is preferred. Please note that any equivalent combination of education, professional licenses/certifications, and experience may be considered. Employees establishing residency in the State of Oregon must obtain an Oregon driver’s license within 30 days.
