RESOLUTION

Resolution No. 09-1: Establishes Polvi Tribute Scholarship Adopted 1/30/09

At its January 30, 2009, meeting, the APWA Scholastic Foundation Board of Trustees voted to establish a new tribute account scholarship at University of Oregon. The scholarship will be titled, 'The Ron Polvi Civil Engineering/Sustainability Scholarship – Oregon State University.'

Eligibility for the scholarship is set as follows:

Full-time civil engineering students who have achieved junior standing at the beginning of the academic year of the award will be considered for the scholarship. Students who receive the award during their junior year will be eligible to apply for the award during their senior year, assuming they maintain eligibility for the scholarship. Course work must be taken at the school where the scholarship is awarded. Women and minorities are encouraged to apply.


Selection criteria is set as follows:

1. Junior or Senior standing at the beginning of the academic year of the award.
2. Student enrolled in a civil engineering program working toward a Bachelor of Science degree, who supports the philosophy of sustainability through personal experience or future aspirations.
3. Demonstrated financial need for the scholarship.
4. United States citizen.
5. Four-year resident of the State of Oregon.


Funds will be distributed in accordance with the Oregon Chapter American Public Works Association Scholastic Foundation disbursement policy.
