RESOLUTION

Resolution No. 09-3: Establishes University of Oregon Sustainability Scholarship

Adopted 10/7/09

At its October 7, 2009, meeting, the APWA Scholastic Foundation Board of Trustees voted to establish a new scholarship at University of Oregon. The scholarship will be funded by an annual donation from Century West Engineering. The scholarship will be titled, 'The APWA – Century West Sustainable Cities Scholarship, University of Oregon'. The scholarship will be administered by the University of Oregon's Center for Sustainable Business Practices.

Eligibility for the scholarship is set as follows:

- Full time graduate students 2nd year and above are eligible to apply.
- Students who receive the award during their 2nd year will be eligible to apply for the award in subsequent years, assuming they maintain eligibility for the scholarship. Course work must be taken at the school where the scholarship is awarded. Women and minorities are encouraged to apply.


Selection criteria is set as follows:


1. Graduate standing, 2nd year or above, at the beginning of the academic year of the award.
2. Student enrolled in Business, Architecture, Law, or Policy/Planning and working toward a graduate degree with an emphasis on sustainable infrastructure and an alignment with the University's Sustainable Cities Initiative.
3. Demonstrated financial need for the scholarship.
4. United States citizen.
5. Four-year resident of the State of Oregon.

Funds will be distributed in accordance with the Oregon Chapter American Public Works Association Scholastic Foundation disbursement policy.

The Scholastic Foundation Board of Directors adopted this resolution on October 7, 2009.
