

\$2,000 Michael Lindberg Scholarship Portland State University

Introduction

The Oregon Chapter of the American Public Works Association (APWA) will award a scholarship to a student enrolled in the Public Administration or Urban Studies program in the College of Urban and Public Affairs at Portland State University. The scholarship is named for former Portland City Commissioner, Michael Lindberg, and was established to recognize and financially assist students who are interested in pursuing a **career in Public Works Administration**.

Eligibility

Students who have achieved graduate standing at the beginning of the academic year of the award will be considered for the scholarship. Students who have completed 30 credits within the MPA program will again be eligible to apply for the award during a subsequent year, provided they maintain eligibility for the scholarship. Course work must be taken at Portland State University. Women and minorities are encouraged to apply.

Selection Criteria

1. Demonstrated financial need for the scholarship
2. Student enrolled in a program working toward a Master or Doctorate of Public Administration or Master or Doctorate of Urban Studies degree, with a major interest in Public Works administration.
3. Graduate standing at the beginning of the academic year of the award.
4. Academic achievement.
4. United States citizen or legal U.S. resident.
5. Four-year resident of the state of Oregon

Procedure

1. **Applicant shall complete and deliver the following application materials to:**

By end of business on

- a. Application Form
- b. Supplemental Information Form
- c. Copy of transcript

2. Portland State University faculty will review the applications and recommend one scholarship applicant to the APWA Scholarship Committee for consideration. The recommendation, along with the requested application materials, should be submitted, via email, to:

3. The APWA Scholarship Committee will review the recommendation and application materials for eligibility and completeness, then submit to the APWA Oregon Chapter Scholastic Foundation for consideration of award.

4. Scholarship award recipients will be notified by:

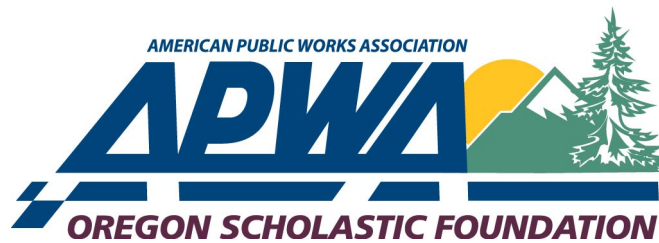
Other information

A total of \$2,000 will be made available to the selected scholarship recipient. Half of the award will be disbursed at the beginning of the Fall Term and the other half at the beginning of Winter Term. **Please note, should the award recipient change their address at any time during the school year, the scholarship committee chair needs to be notified ASAP to avoid any delay in the student receiving their scholarship funds.**

The scholarship recipient will be invited to attend either the fall or spring Chapter Conference to not only be recognized for their achievements but to also network with engineers and public works professionals from both the public and private sectors. The fall conference is generally held in mid- to late October and the spring conference is generally held in early to mid-April. Registration fees will be covered for scholarship recipients by the Chapter and once in-person conferences resume, meals and lodging will also be included. It should be noted that lodging will be limited to one room for women and another room for men with a two-person per room maximum. Students are responsible for their own transportation to and from the conference, however, ride share opportunities may be available with other conference attendees.

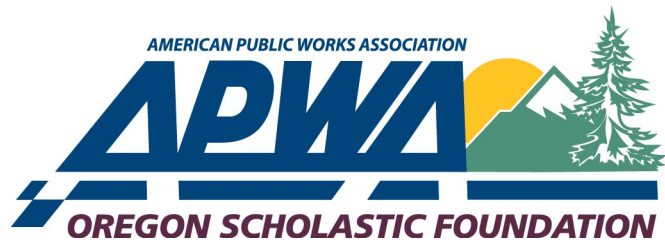

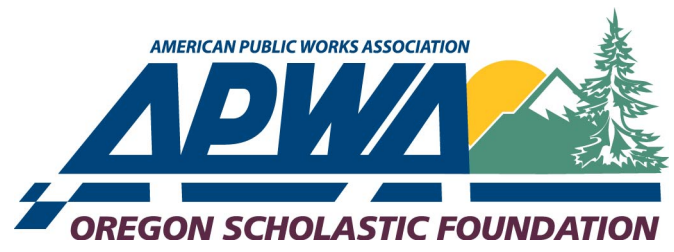
